

Type-Approval Process Guideline

National Telematics Framework

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1 Introduction

1.1 What Is Type-Approval?

Type-approval is the process by which TCA independently assesses hardware and system 'devices' for conformance against performance-based requirements.

1.2 Application Pack

An Applicant will be provided with an application pack which contains the documents required to apply for type-approval. The Application Pack will contain the following documents:

- Type-Approval Process Guideline (this document)
- Type-Approval Checklist
- Relevant Functional and Technical Specification
- Due Diligence Assessment Form (if required)
- Type-Approval Agreement (sample)
- Certificate of Conformance (sample).

TCA will appoint a dedicated person to progress type-approval with the Applicant.

1.3 How to Apply

2 Type-Approval Process




Figure 1: The stages of the type-approval process

There are three stages in the type-approval process (Figure 1).

TCA will advise the Applicant upon the completion of each stage.

2.1 The Application and Checklist Stage

The focus of this stage is to ensure that the Applicant demonstrates conformance with the relevant Specification/s.

Key actions to be completed by the Applicant during the Application and Checklist Stage:

- · Complete and submit the Application Form for Type-Approval
- Complete and submit the Type-Approval Checklist and supporting documentation
- Complete and submit the Due Diligence Assessment Form (as required)
- Provide TCA with further information if requested to do so.

Key actions to be completed by TCA during the Application and Checklist Stage:

- Review the Type-Approval Checklist
- Provide the Applicant with Due Diligence Assessment Form (if required)
- Notify the Applicant of the outcome (progress to next stage / more information required).

2.2 Risk Focused Review Stage

The focus of this stage is to perform a risk-based assessment of the information provided by the Applicant in the Type-approval Checklist.

TCA may require additional information, or perform specific tests of the device or system, to independently verify conformance with specific functional and technical requirements of relevant specification/s.

Key actions to be completed by the Applicant during the Risk Focused Review Stage:

- Provide TCA with device or system
- Provide further information as requested.

Key actions to be completed by TCA during the Application and Checklist Stage:

- Complete Risk Focused Review
- Complete Assessment
- Notify the Applicant of the outcome (progress to next stage / more information required).

2.3 Type-Approval Stage

The focus of this stage is to finalise the type-approval process, and enter into a type-approval agreement for the device or system so that a Type-Approval Agreement can be executed.

TCA will return to the Applicant any devices or systems submitted to TCA (if applicable).

Key actions to be completed by the Applicant during the Type-Approval Stage:

- Applicant to provide TCA with any final further information (if required)
- Applicant to sign a Type-Approval agreement.

Key actions to be completed by TCA during the Type-Approval Stage:

- Notify the Applicant of the outcome (Application approved / Application not approved)
- Provide Applicant with a Type-Approval Agreement
- Issue Type-Approval Certificate
- Issue Media Release
- Return to the Applicant all equipment submitted to TCA (if applicable)
- Where an application has not been approved, TCA will follow up to discuss the issues and the options available to obtain approval.

3 Certificates of Conformance

Certificates of Conformance are issued by TCA to Suppliers (referred to as Applicants during the type-approval process) to accompany each type-approved "device" or "system" supplied to end-users.

After type-approval has been granted, the Supplier shall notify TCA of their intention to commence the supply of a type-approved "device" to end-users.


TCA will provide the Supplier with a serialised Certificate of Conformance for each individual typeapproved "device" that is to be supplied.

The purpose of the Certificate of Conformance is to confirm that the Specific "device" supplied conforms to the type-approved "device" by TCA (see sample Schedule D of the sample Agreement in the Application Pack).

The issuance of a Certificate of Conformance is subject to a fee. Please visit the TCA website for further details www.tca.gov.au.

Key actions to be completed by the Supplier once type-approval has been granted:

- Advise TCA of the particulars of each individual "device" that they supply or intend to supply to a customer
- Make payment of fees related to the issuance of Certificates of Conformance.





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
