



All vehicles enrolled in the IAP in QLD must transition to TMA by 1 June 2024. You can transfer vehicle enrolment any time before that date.

Customers with affected vehicles currently enrolled in IAP will need to transition to TMA. Application Service Providers should provide advice on this transition.

Customers will advise when they are ready to begin their transition to TMA

Frontline staff should support customers by:

- · Ensuring customers sign ASP-TO consent agreements
- · Cancelling Intelligent Access Conditions with TMR

In the Higher Mass Limits (HML) scheme in QLD, vehicle configuration and mass must be self-declared through a user interface installed by the Application Service Provider. However, if the vehicle already has a Smart OBM system installed, that device will collect this information instead.





My customer has vehicles enrolled in IAP with an Interim OBM system installed. What do I do now?



All vehicles enrolled in the IAP in QLD must transition to TMA and either upgrade or purchase a new Smart OBM system in QLD by 1 June 2024. You can transfer vehicle enrolment any time before that date.

Customers with affected vehicles currently enrolled in IAP and using Interim OBM systems will need to transition to TMA and either upgrade to or purchase a new Smart OBM system. An existing OBM system may be upgradeable to a Smart OBM system – suppliers can provide further advice.
